

PROCLAMATION

TERMINATING A COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY

COUNTY OF RUTHERFORD, NORTH CAROLINA

On March 16, 2020, at 2:00 pm, I determined and proclaimed a local State of Emergency for the County of Rutherford pursuant to Section 5-22 of the Rutherford County State of Emergency Ordinance and Chapter 166A of North Carolina's General Statutes due to the imminent threat of widespread or severe illness, injury or loss of life resulting from the COVID-19 virus pandemic. This proclamation was amended by Amended Proclamation of County State of Emergency executed April 16, 2020, at 3:30 p.m.

In acknowledgement of Executive Order No. 267 Termination of the COVID-19 State of Emergency signed by North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper on August 15, 2022, I hereby terminate the Proclamation of a County State of Emergency and Amended Proclamation of a County State of Emergency and all of the restrictions and orders therein.

This proclamation is effective immediately. Proclaimed this the 2nd day of September 2022 at 3:30 p.m.
