

About the Market

The Farmers' Market opened June 20, 1975 as a marketing vehicle for the local agricultural producers.

During the growing season a wide selection of produce items are sold by the farmers from across the county. Baked goods and handcrafted items are also available for purchase.

The Farmers' Market is open for business on *Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturdays*. The average season is May through October.

Hours of operation are:

Tuesday 7a.m. - 12 noon
Thursday 1 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
Saturday 8 a.m. - 12 noon
