Rutherford County Transit will be closed but will be providing dialysis transportation only beginning at 12:00 p.m.

Rutherford County Senior Center and all satellite meal sites will be closed, and there will be no home-delivered meals or on-site meals Thursday, January 18, 2018. The Senior Center full-time staff will report to work at 12:00 p.m.
