Rutherford County Solid Waste Hauler Permit Requirements

This application is for any person or company seeking a permit to collect, transport, and dispose for a fee, Solid waste and/or recyclables originating in Rutherford County.

The applicant agrees to:

- Make every effort to communicate state bans to customers, and to promote waste reduction and recycling.
- Secure all loads. A secured load is a load of material that has been tied, tarped, secured or covered in the vehicle in a manner that will prevent any material from leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is in motion.
- Ensure the destination facility is authorized to accept the materials being hauled.
- Report annual tonnages and destination facilities for all waste and recyclables collected in Rutherford County.
- Provide an alphabetized listing of residential customers and by the 15th of the first month of every quarter a list of added and removed customers.
- Provide a schedule of fees (will not be published).
- Obtain or provide all necessary permits, authorizations or licenses required by any local, state or federal agency and all necessary insurances to operate vehicles.
- Ensure that operators of any vehicle covered by this application have no outstanding notices of violation from local, state or federal authorities that could affect permits, authorizations or licenses required for operation.
- Clearly and prominently mark vehicles and debris containers as belonging to the owner (with the name of the business entity or the county permit # no smaller than 3 inches on both sides of the vehicles).
- Notify Rutherford County Solid Waste of any changes in the application document within 30 days.
- Submit a balance sheet or equivalent financial statement prepared by a certified public accountant or other person at close of applicant's last business year, showing the net worth of the business. All financial data submitted shall be confidential and not regarded as public information.
- Submit permit application and all required documents by the 31st day of January.
- All rules can be found in **Section 15-33 of the Rutherford County Solid Waste Code**.

- Schedule of fees in sealed envelope to Sherry Lavender (will not be published)**
- Certificate of liability insurance coverage**
- Annual report of all tonnages and destination facilities for previous year.**

I declare that all information contained in this application is true and agree to comply with all requirements. I acknowledge that any false statements made herein and/or failure to comply will result in the revocation of our permit.
