When coal is burned to generate electricity for customers, it creates non-hazardous coal ash. That material is recycled or safely stored on plant property, and the company routinely monitors the storage locations and groundwater.

We are considering many safe options to close ash basins. To help meet a state deadline of 2022 for the Asheville Plant, we began transporting ash to the Cliffside landfill, which is a ready-to-use, fully lined operating facility in close proximity. Please join us on June 30 for this drop-in event to learn more about our operations and plans; there will be no formal presentation. Company experts will be available to answer your questions and share information. We also will offer bus tours of the site.
