

Rutherford County has an EMS Operations Manager position available. An employee in this class plans, organizes and manages the operational activities of the emergency medical services for the County. Work involves participation in budget preparation and administration and personnel staffing and training, development and implementation of policies and procedures, and regulatory management and compliance for the division. The employee is responsible for equipment and facilities maintenance oversight, staff scheduling, purchasing supplies and medications, and addressing issues with patients and the public. Work requires short range planning for staffing, equipment, supplies and technology and knowledge of trends, liability issues, and rapidly changing medical sciences and protocols. Work involves a broad scope of public contacts, a variety of technical and detailed knowledge, and independent initiative and judgement. Employee must possess a thorough knowledge of federal, state, and local laws, policies, procedures, and regulations pertaining to emergency medical and other related services.

Desirable Education and Experience

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with a degree in public or business administration or related field and considerable supervisory experience in emergency medical services; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Certification by the State as an Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic.
- 5-10 years experience as paramedic with 3-5 years supervisory experience preferred
